Habema Initiated Communal Work To Repair The Mumugu Rimba School Building

NDUGA- One of the military units under the command of the Indonesian Armed Forces Operational Command HABEMA, the Task Forces of the Para Raider Infantry Battalion 503/Mayangkara Kostrad, is currently conducting mobile security at the border of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, especially in Nduga Regency, Papua Pegunungan Province. On Monday, 26 August 2024, the 503

Task Forces completed the communal work with the Mumugu residents in repairing a building of the "Sekolah Rimba (Jungle School)".

The communal work was conducted due to Social Communication (Komsos) which was actively organized by the 503 Task Forces. According to the 503 Task Forces Commander, Lieutenant Colonel Gurbasa Samosir, the Komsos is an implementation of the TNI's commitment to implementing inclusive social communication with all components of the community within the Papua region. It resulted in the implementation of communal work which ran safely and smoothly and involved many parties who could speed up the repairment of the school.

The Mumugu residents enthusiastically welcomed the initiative of the 503 Task Forces to repair the condition of the Sekolah Rimba building. It was due to the residents' limitations in providing building materials. Eventually, on Monday afternoon, the process was completed successfully.
